



Dental Assistant



(Ukiah)

Description: This is a hands-on, didactic course that offers certificates in dental imaging and coronal polishing. Learn all aspects of the role of a professional dental assistant, including procedures, instruments, safety, hygiene, and dental vocabulary. You will learn front office procedures as well as patient room chairside assistance.



Salary Potential: \$12-\$27 per hour



10 weeks plus a 120 hour externship

Cost: \$3,000 (subject to change) cost includes classroom supplies, CPR certification, and background check. Additional fees may vary for certification testing and scrubs.

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination and ability to pass drug screening and background check.

Certified Nurse Assistant CNA



(Lakeport)

Description: Upon completion of the Certified Nurse Assistant program students will be allowed to sit for their state certification through the American Red Cross. Most Nurse Assistants work in skilled nursing facilities providing daily care to residents.



Salary potential: \$12-\$15 per hour



Time: 13 weeks

Cost: \$1,000 cost includes textbooks, blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, fingerprinting, and drug screening.

Prerequisites: Students must be 18 years or older, not enrolled in high school, passage of drug screening, fingerprinting and ability to pass a background check.

Emergency Medical Technician EMT



(Gualala)


Description: This course prepares students for both Emergency and Interfacility transports of sick and injured patients as well as the National Registry EMT test which is required for certification. Classes are offered in Anderson Valley, Ukiah, Laytonville, Lakeport and Mendocino. This course is certified with both Coastal Valleys EMS and North Coast EMS.



Salary Potential: \$11-\$18 per hour



Time: 5 months (160 hours) training. This includes classroom instruction as well as ambulance ride along time and training in an Emergency Room setting.



Prerequisites: CPR card; (Health 202 recommended)

Emergency Medical Technician



(Anderson Valley, Ukiah, Laytonville, Lakeport and Mendocino)

Description: MCOE offers an EMT program on the south coast in Gualala. EMT's (Emergency Medical Technician) administer first aid treatment and transport sick or injured persons to medical facilities. This course is certified with the Coastal Valley EMS Agency and will prepare you to sit for the National Registry EMT exam.



Salary Potential: \$11-\$18 per hour



Time: 5 Months (160 hours) training. This includes classroom instruction as well as ambulance ride along time and training in an Emergency Room setting.

Cost: \$695 (subject to change). Additional fees for NREMT Exam, Local EMS Agency certification and state certifications.

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination and ability to pass drug screening and background check.

Description: The study of drawing blood for laboratory testing in a hospital, laboratory, or blood bank setting. Phlebotomy is a one semester classroom course as well as on-the-job externship. Students will learn to administer skin punctures as well as vein-punctures, as well as learn all aspects and responsibilities entailed in phlebotomy work. At the conclusion of the classroom training, students must pass the National Healthcare Association CPT1 exam prior to starting externship.



Salary Potential: \$12-\$27 per hour



Time: 5 months plus a 40 hour externship

Cost: \$2,000 (subject to change) cost includes textbooks and supplies, drug screen and background check. Additional fees required for national exam as well as state certification fee (fees vary).

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma, or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination and ability to pass drug screening and ability to pass a background check.

Certified Medical Assistant



(Ukiah)

Description: This course prepares students for all aspects of work as a Medical Assistant in both the Administrative and Clinical setting. Students will learn all aspects from scheduling patients, computer skills, and greeting patients, to rooming patients, giving injections, and taking vital signs. Course prepares students to sit for the California Certifying Board Medical Assistant exam.



Salary Potential: \$15-\$19 per hour



Time: 10 months plus a 200 hour externship

Cost: \$3,500 (subject to change) cost includes textbooks and supplies, drug screen and background check. Additional fees required for national exam as well as state certification fee (fees vary).

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma, or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination ability to pass drug screening and ability to pass a background check.

Certified Medical Assistant



(Lakeport)

Description: Upon completion of the Medical Assistant program students will be allowed to sit for their national certification through the National Center for Competency Testing for both front and back office. Students will also be eligible to take the state exam through the California Board for Medical Assistants. Medical Assistants are tasked with working in doctors' offices and clinics to assist the physician with weights and measures, injections, phlebotomy and other in office procedures.



Salary potential: \$15-\$19 per hour



Time: 10 months plus 180 hours externship

Cost: \$4,300 cost includes textbooks, CPR Certification, blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, fingerprinting, and drug screening.

Prerequisites: High school diploma or equivalency, passage of drug screening and fingerprinting. Students are encouraged to complete a community college course in Medical Terminology prior to starting the class. Students who do not take the course prior to the class will be enrolled in a Medical Terminology course concurrently.

Vocational Nursing Program



(Ukiah)

Description: Upon completion of the Vocational Nursing program, graduates will be eligible to take the NCLEX licensure exam. LVNs work in a variety of settings, including acute care, rehab, long-term care and doctors' offices, clinics and in-home environments. Projected increase in need for LVNs over the 10 years between 2012 and 2022 is up to 25%.



Salary potential: \$17-\$29 per hour



Time: 18 months

Description: Mendocino College offers a 3-semester LVN to RN Bridge Program. Students who successfully complete the Bridge program are awarded the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing and are eligible to sit for the California State Board of Registered Nursing Licensing Exam (NCLEX-RN). The Mendocino College LVN to RN program was accredited in 2003 by the California State Board of Registered Nursing.
