10. Member Updates-Program Review Presentations

(Action/Discussion)

(Members will present program review for 17-18 school year)

- a. Anderson Valley USD
 - Parent Education 24 students were enrolled in this class last semester. Currently this class has 10 students enrolled. Elementary teachers reported significant gains in the children of parents who consistently attended the program last year.
 - Citizenship 14 students were enrolled in this class last fiscal year. Currently this class has 14 students enrolled. 4 students attained their citizenship last year and 1 student this year as well.





- **Bilingual Literacy** 6 students were enrolled in this class last fiscal year and currently has 9 students enrolled. There are no Spanish literacy assessment tools currently made available by the state.
- Basic Computer Skills 6 students were enrolled last fiscal year and currently 8 students are enrolled. Support is needed on how to demonstrate gains for this course. Possibly a certificate of completion.
- **High School Equivalency** –15 students were enrolled last Fall and 14 last Spring. Currently there are 9 students enrolled. 5 students have completed their high school equivalency while four students have passes subtests but have not passed the full exam.
- **ESL In Home Caregiver** 16 students have now been enrolled this fiscal year. This is a new program that just started this fall semester so no outcomes have yet been recorded.
- **ESL Intermediate** 16 students were enrolled last Fall and 20 students were enrolled in the Spring. Currently there are 23 students enrolled this Fall semester.
- ESL Beginner 26 students were enrolled last Fall and 35 last Spring. Currently there are 19 students enrolled this Fall semester.

b. Ft. Bragg USD

- ESL Beginner 52 students were enrolled last fiscal year and there are now 19 enrolled this semester.
- Citizenship ESL 56 students were enrolled last fiscal year and 28 students are now enrolled this Fall. 30 students have had a NRS literacy gain.
- CNA Tutoring 2 students were enrolled last fiscal year. Currently there are 3 students enrolled this fiscal
 year.
- **High School Diploma** 36 students were enrolled last fiscal year and 11 are now currently enrolled this fiscal year.

c. Kelseyville USD

- HiSET Prep in Spanish 5 students enrolled and this is the program that is under a program review.
- **High School Diploma Program** 76 students were enrolled last fiscal year and this fiscal year 38 students are currently enrolled. 18 students received their diploma last fiscal year and 6 have so far this fiscal year.
- Citizenship Not being offered this semester. Funds are being flexed with other programs.

d. Lake COE

- CNA Program 26 enrolled last fiscal year 22 completed. This program is not being currently being ran.
- CNA Continuing Education 11 enrolled
- HiSET 12 students enrolled
- MA 19 students enrolled last fiscal year and 13 students enrolled this fiscal year.
- Program Assistant Interviews are being held and will hopefully have position filled soon.
- Anatomy Table has been purchased for the medical students.
- e. Mendocino College
 - Christy presented how the money is being spent by the Mendocino College. See Appendix B
- f. Mendocino COE
 - MA 20 students enrolled this fiscal year
 - Phlebotomy 20 students enrolled this fiscal year
 - **Dental** 16 students enrolled this fiscal year
- g. Ukiah USD
 - UVAH 146 students last fiscal year and 98 students enrolled this fiscal year.
 - Correctional Facility 229 students last fiscal year and 46 this fiscal year.
 - ESL 72 students last fiscal year and 48 this fiscal year.
 - PearsonVue Testing 424 exams delivered
 - High School Diploma Program 155 students last year and currently 90 students are now enrolled
 - **GED Prep** 39 students last year and currently 8 enrolled students.
 - Citizenship 23 students last year and currently 14 students enrolled.
 - Round Valley 38 students last year and currently 15 students enrolled.
 - Vocational Nursing Program 37 students enrolled and 34 are now currently enrolled.

- i. Round Valley USD Emily explained how unique the programs are running in Round Valley. The school district does not receive any funds from MLACE to run these programs. The programs that are ran in Round Valley are from funds out of Ukiah USD and Mendocino College apportionment.
