

Dental Assistant DA

(Ukiah)

Description: This is a hands-on, didactic course that offers certificates in dental imaging and coronal polishing. Learn all aspects of the role of a professional dental assistant, including procedures, instruments, safety, hygiene, and dental vocabulary. You will learn front office procedures as well as patient room chairside assistance.



Salary Potential: \$12-\$27 per hour 5 months plus 120 hour externship

Cost: \$4,000 (all fees subject to change each year) cost includes classroom supplies, CPR certification, and background check. Additional fees may vary for certification testing and scrubs.

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination, and ability to pass drug screening, and ability to pass a background check.

Certified Nursing Assistant CNA

(Lakeport)

Description: The Lake County Office of Education Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program focuses on patient care in a skilled nursing facility or hospital setting. Students who successfully complete the program will be able to sit for the California state certification exam.





Time: 13 weeks

Cost: \$1,250 (subject to change) cost includes textbooks, blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, fingerprinting, and drug screening.

Emergency Medical Technician

(Anderson Valley, Ukiah, Laytonville, Lakeport and Mendocino)

Description: This course prepares students for both Emergency and Inter-facility transports of sick and injured patients as well as the National Registry EMT test which is required for certification. Classes are offered in Anderson Valley, Ukiah, Laytonville, Lakeport and Mendocino. This course is certified with both Coastal Valley EMS and North Coast EMS.



Salary Potential: \$11-\$18 per hour



Time: 5 months (160 hours) training. This includes classroom instruction as well as ambulance ride along time and training in an Emergency Room setting.

Cost: \$322 plus approx. \$200 for books and a \$20 material fee, financial aid may be available.

Phlebotomy Phile

(Ukiah)

Description: The study of drawing blood for laboratory testing in a hospital, laboratory, or blood bank setting. Phlebotomy is a one semester classroom course as well as on-the-job externship. Students will learn to administer skin punctures as well as vein-punctures, as well as learn all aspects and responsibilities entailed in phlebotomy work. At the conclusion of the classroom training, students must pass the National Healthcare Association CPT1 exam prior to starting externship.







Time: 5 months plus 40 hour externship

Cost: \$2,800 (all fees subject to change each year) cost includes textbooks and supplies, drug screen and background check. Additional fees required for national exam as well as state certification fee (fees vary).

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma, or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination and ability to pass drug screening and ability to pass a background check.

Certified Medical Assistant MA

(Ukiah)

Description: Upon completion of the Medical Assistant program students will be allowed to sit for their national certification through the National Center for Competency Testing for both front and back office. Students will also be eligible to take the state exam through the California Board for Medical Assistants. Medical Assistants are tasked with working in doctors' offices and clinics to assist the physician with weights and measures, injections, phlebotomy and other in office procedures.



Salary Potential: \$15-\$19 per hour



Time: 8 months plus a 140 hour externship

Cost: \$4,500 (subject to change) cost includes textbooks and supplies, drug screen, and background check. Additional fees required for the national exam as well as state certification fees (fees vary).

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, high school diploma, or equivalency, a passing score on a basic skills examination, ability to pass drug screening, and ability to pass a background check.

Certified Medical Assistant MA

(Lakeport)

The Lake County Office of Education's Medical Assistant program is the only program of its kind in Lake County, with a long history of graduating students who go on to become successful Medical Assistants. With an intensive format, students complete the program in only nine months. The program's 500 hours of classroom instruction are provided by skilled instructors with years of experience in the healthcare industry. The 180-hour medical externship enables students to work in medical offices throughout Lake County. Externship duties include clinical tasks such as taking vitals, preparing lab specimens, sterilizing instruments, and removing sutures, and administrative tasks include greeting patients, scheduling appointments, and assisting with billing. These hands-on learning experiences lead to greater understanding of program content, as well as potential job opportunities upon program completion.



Salary potential: \$18-\$23 per hour



Time: 9 months, including 180 hour externship

Cost: \$4,550 (subject to change) cost includes textbooks, CPR Certification, blood pressure cuff, stethoscope, fingerprinting, and drug screening. Application available online: www.lakecoe.org/adulted

Vocational Nursing Program VN

(Ukiah)

Description: Upon completion of the Vocational Nursing program, graduates will be eligible to take the NCLEX licensure exam. VNs work in a variety of settings, including acute care, rehab, long-term care and doctors' offices, clinics and in-home environments. Projected increase in need for VNs between 2022 and 2029 will be about 9%.



Salary potential: \$17-\$37 per hour

Licensed Vocational Nurse to Registered Nurse Bridge Program LVN TO RN

(Ukiah)

Description: Mendocino College offers a 3-semester LVN to RN Bridge Program. Students who successfully complete the Bridge program are awarded the Associate of Science Degree in Nursing and are eligible to sit for the California State Board of Registered Nursing Licensing Exam (NCLEX-RN). The Mendocino College LVN to RN program was accredited in 2003 by the California State Board of Registered Nursing.



Salary Potential: \$37-\$79 per hour



Cost: \$4,400 Financial aid may be available Prerequisites: (Same as RN program) and must be a LVN

Time: 18 months. One transition semester in the Spring requiring a 1-day a week class after which students "bridge" into third

Physical Therapist Assistant PTA

The PTA program is a five-semester program with students earning an Associates of Science degree and eligibility to take the National Physical Therapy Exam for licensure as a PTA upon completion.

The program is commuter-friendly and simply requires that students be on campus in Ukiah two consecutive days per week for laboratory courses during the spring and fall semesters, while lecture courses are taught online.

Physical Therapy is a dynamic profession full of variety, activity, and human interaction. PTs and PTAs are movement experts who help to relieve pain, prevent disability, and restore the basic movements that we take for granted every day by improving balance, posture, strength, flexibility and so much more. PTAs are an integral part of the healthcare team and work in a variety of settings including hospitals, private practices, outpatient clinics, home health, nursing homes, schools, sports facilities, and more.


